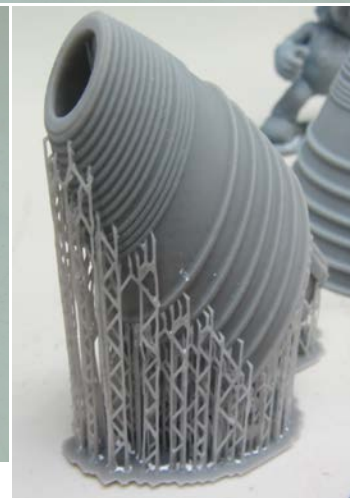

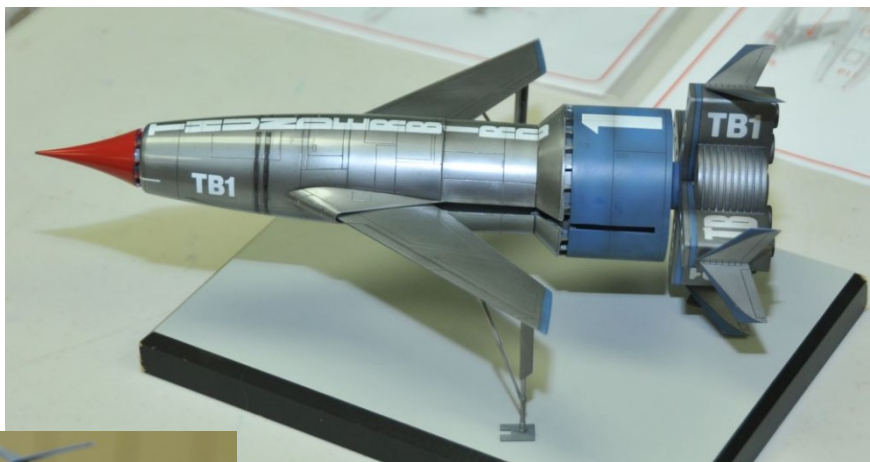

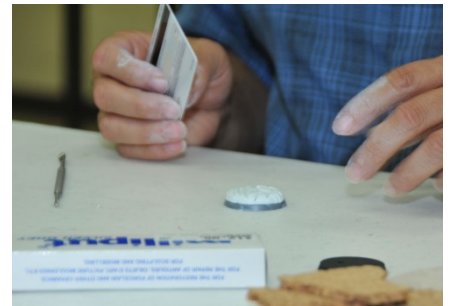

Union Pacific Big Boy

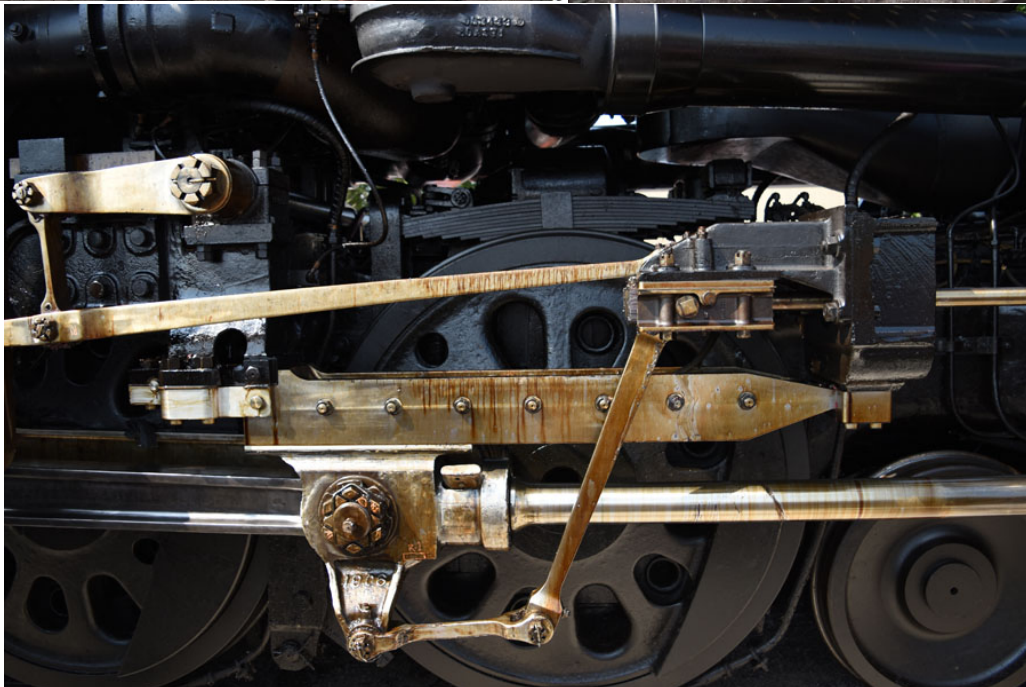
This weekend a restored “Big Boy” locomotive stopped in West Chicago for public viewing. It was not my first time seeing one up close; I had seen several on display previously, much like the bones of ancient dinosaurs in some natural history museum, impressive but cold and lifeless. This was different. It arrived here under its own power and you quickly understood that even sleeping, there was a giant waiting to awaken.

Tuesday morning I waited in a field outside of town for it, and it was a memorable experience. You first hear a sound that’s “different”, and then you notice smoke rising above the distant trees. Then you hear it, that first faint, low moaning wail of its whistle. Something different this way comes!

As it draws nearer, the sound begins to reverberate off the trees, and then finally it comes in to view, 1.2 *million* pounds steel, iron, oil and water go pounding past in a wail of steam and sound. In an age of devices that race to be the smallest and least obtrusive, here is a giant from the past, that is among the greatest examples of mechanical design by man and perhaps one of the vital steps leading up to the Saturn moon rockets. The finest Hi-fidelity recordings cannot capture the sounds and your eyes only the fleeting image of a time gone by.

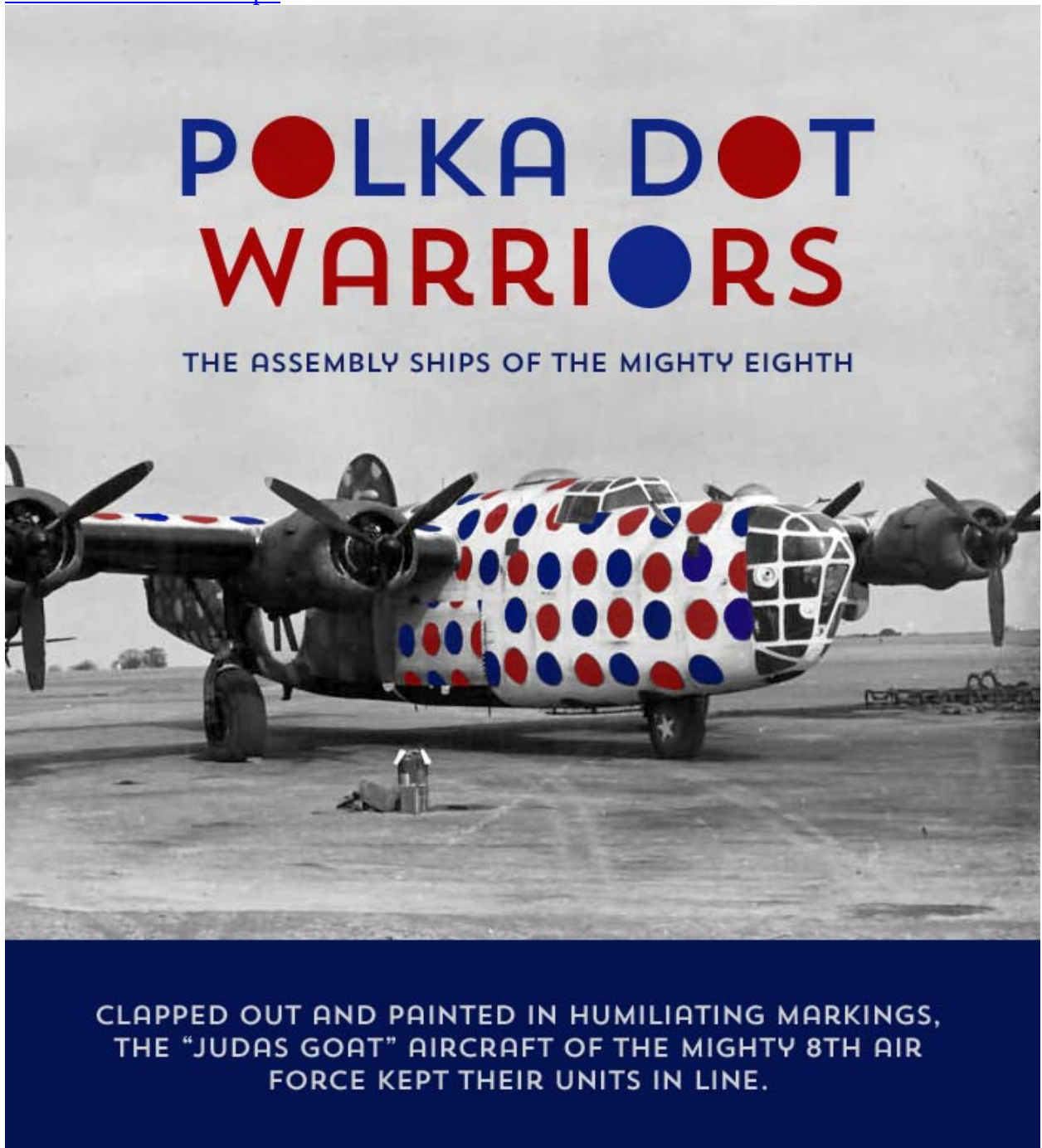
It was an honor to see it and an experience I will never forget.

Junior- 17 years or younger, \$17 per year

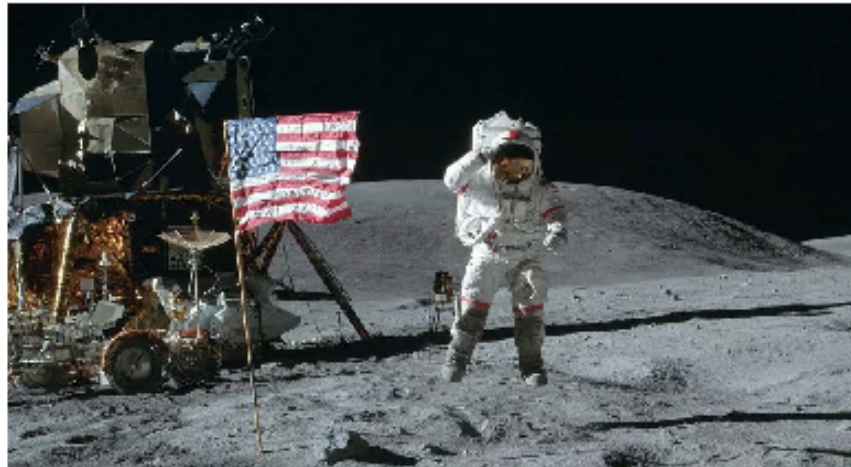
