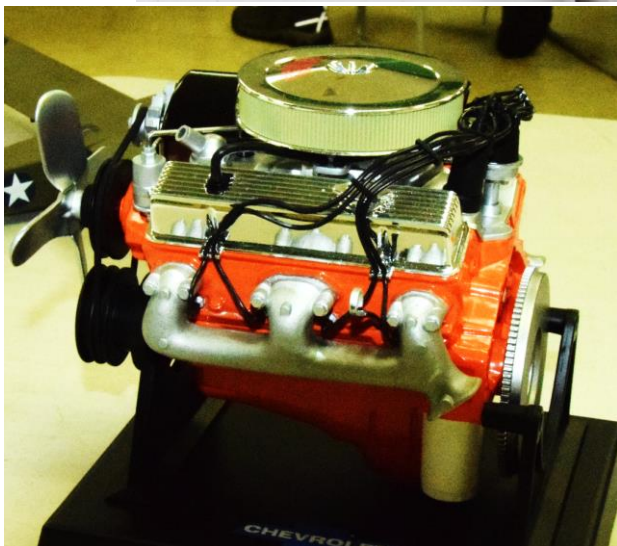

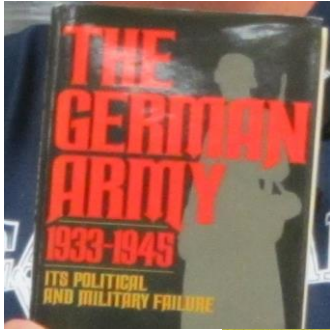

IPMS News and Update

You may have already heard via other sources, but I want to make you aware that IPMS Region 5 is being split into two separate regions. The main reason for this is the size of Region 5, both in the number of clubs and geographic area. R5 has forty-two clubs, while most other regions have less than twenty. Also, the driving distance to the southern part of the region usually prohibits those in the northern part from going to contests in the south, and vice-versa.

Effective immediately Region 5 will consist of the Chicago-area chapters, Wisconsin, Minnesota, and South Dakota.

The new IPMS Region 14 will consist of Iowa, Nebraska, eastern Kansas, Missouri, and the non-Chicago area part of Illinois. The new RC for Region 14 is Bob Delaney of the St. Louis Gateway chapter.

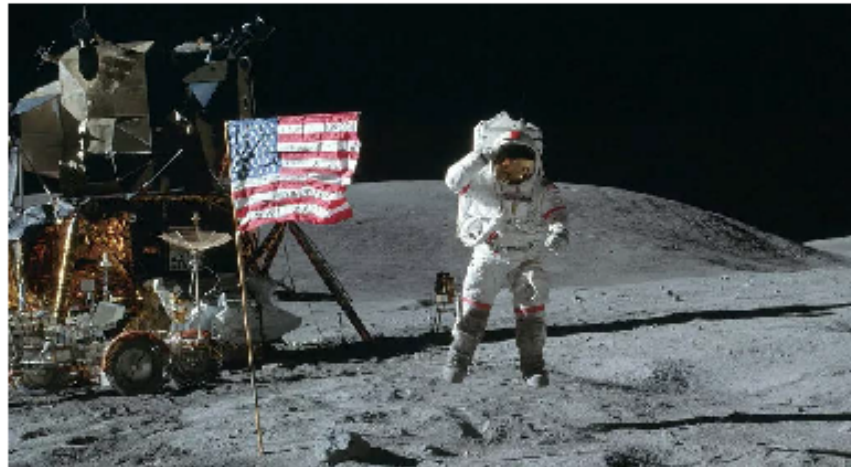
