## **December 2021 Meeting Recap and Other News**

President John Novak brought the meeting to order. There were 18 people in attendance. John presented his thoughts about our November Show. He then went over the agenda for the meeting: which included a number of free kits (many were already grabbed up before the meeting started), a white elephant exchange, officer elections, and collection of dues for next year. Treasurer Hector Colon also presented his thoughts about our 2021 Show. He summarized the model contest which included some 249 entries of which there were 41 gold, 64 silver, and 84 bronze medals awarded. The Show netted a small profit for our club. Hector thanked all those that helped at the Show.

For next year's Show, risers will be used on the contest tables to make viewing easier for both judges and show attendees. John mentioned that he would like us to have a Show banner to use at next year's Show. He also suggested that we use small, thin plastic or other stiff material sheets to be placed under all contest entries that do not include a base, thus allowing judges to safely turn the models to view all sides of an entry more effectively. John also stated that he is not in favor of raising Show entry or contest entry fees. (**Note**: Hector Colon has been indicating that he does not want to be the 2022 Show coordinator, so anybody that may want to hold this prestigious position should get in touch with Hector.)

Hector brought up the possibility of our club hosting a regional IPMS Show in 2023. To do this, we would need additional help from club members and from other clubs. He discussed how the regional shows only have a first, second, and third place winner per category; but there are also many more categories. Any regional show BOH might host would need to be held earlier (e.g., mid- to late-summer) than our usual November date.

Elections were then held. As there were no opposition candidates for current officers (who agreed to another year's term), our club officers for next year will remain as: John Novak – President, Bob Frysztak – Vice President, Bill Vinikour – Secretary, and Hector Colon – Treasurer. Two new officer positions were also established: Newsletter Editor – Ihor Hlohowskyj and Sergeant-at-Arms – Mike Knowski.


A discussion was then brought up about having a Club-only model table, with the theme of 'Battle of Midway,' at next year's Show. This could be a model of any item that was used during the Battle. The best model would receive a special best-theme award. (Maybe a club member would like to generate a list of ships, planes, etc. that took part in the Battle to give out to club members.)

Show-and-tell then took place (see these elsewhere in the Newsletter). A highlight was Mike Grajek (Don's grandson) bringing in a cataloged archive of Don's complete 1/72 build of all the squadrons that had ever been posted out of NAS Pensacola (see pages 6 and 14). Info included tables listing each aircraft type; its squadron, air group, and carrier; paint scheme, notable associated aviator; and the date of when Don built the kit. Also included in the archive are individual photos of each of the aircraft in the collection. An incredible archive of an amazing collection, which is planned for going to the National Naval Aviation Museum at NAS Pensacola.

Finally, the white elephant exchange was held, and fun was had by all that participated! Even without our usual Holiday dinner, the meeting was an enjoyable way to end our 2021 year – hope you all have a happy 2022 modeling year!






