June 2021 Meeting Recap and Other News

President John Novak brought the meeting to order. This was our first in-person meeting since we switched to a Zoom-only format due to the pandemic. A Zoom option was still available to those who could not attend in person. There were 18 in-person attendees and another 3 on Zoom. Since our Zoom account runs to the end of the year, we may continue this hybrid (in-person and Zoom) meeting format until then. There were many magazines and some kits available as giveaways. John mentioned that we may have a club auction in the future of kits not suitable for our November Show raffle. He also asked folks to bring in items for show and tell, even those previously shown on our Zoom meetings. Hector Colon reminded those in attendance that club dues need to be paid. Three people did pay their dues at the meeting.

Hector stated that we are looking at using Buildings 2 and 3 at the DuPage County Fairgrounds for our November Show, but may also go with Building 1. He also discussed the following judging change: judges will put down medals by a model as they judge so that we can avoid the long time needed to hand out medals at the end of the Show. There will be no lanyards on the medals this year. Only the special awards will be presented at the end of the Show. Attendees will be moved out of the model entry area when judging begins. This will make judging more efficient and increase browsing at the dealer tables. There will be teams of three judges including an experienced judge, a not-so-experienced judge, and a novice judge. John also stated that we need to have judging sessions at some of our upcoming meetings. We will need plenty of judges for our Nov Show, as we are anticipating many model entries this year than in past years.

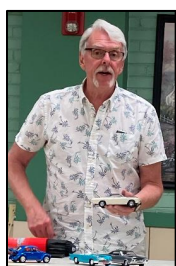

John Bishop, Kevin Stover, and Jim Fulkerson gave overviews of the recent Wonderfest. Hector then gave his treasurer's report. We have enough money to cover the rental fee for the November show. Our payments for the church and Zoom are our only ongoing expenses. Ihor Hlohowskyj asked that people send their show-and-tell photos along with a brief description of each to the BOH Gmail.

Show and tell then took place. Before the meeting ended, John gave an update on Don Grajek. Several members that visited him recently joined in that discussion.

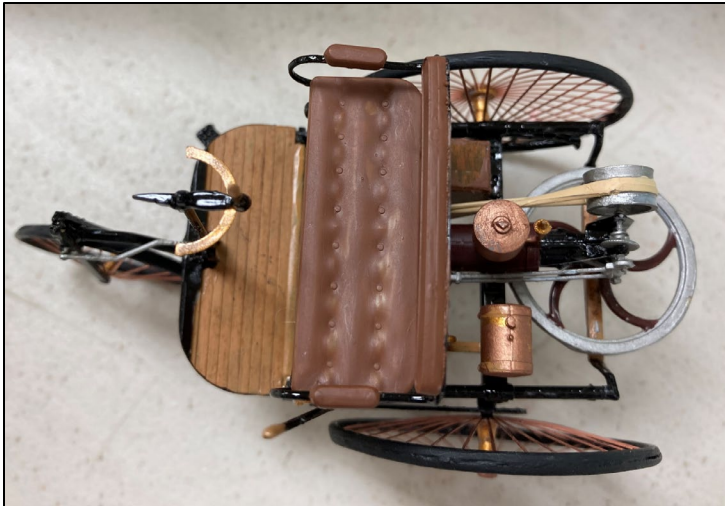

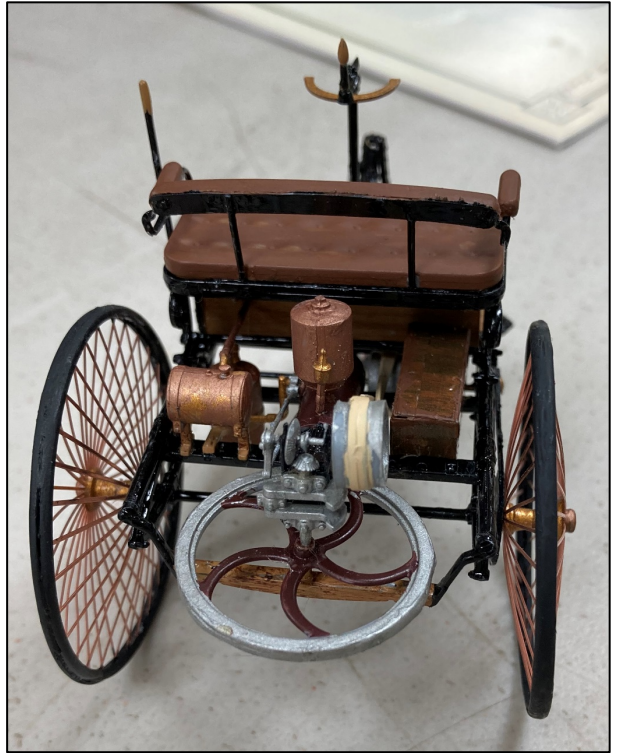
