January 2022 Meeting Recap and Other News


President John Novak brought the Zoom meeting to order. There were 15 people in attendance. The main topic covered in the meeting related to our club being rechartered with IPMS/USA. IPMS/USA has switched to on online format. Thus, IPMS/USA members need to login to the IPMS/USA site and edit their profile to include Butch O'Hare as their local chapter. Those that are board members also need to add that information to their profile. We need at least five club members to be IPMS/USA members to maintain our charter. Hector Colon reiterated the need to do this later in the meeting.

John mentioned that he still has some kits to give away. These are mostly non-raffle quality donations, like the kits that were given out during our December meeting. He would also like us to share information we may have on what may be going on at local hobby shops. Hector mentioned that he is working on a six-foot tall banner on Butch O'Hare. This will be displayed at our annual shows as well as other shows (recruiting events). He also mentioned that our club finances our doing well.

Show-and-tell then took place (see these elsewhere in the Newsletter). The show and tell theme was "What I Got for Christmas." Mike Knowski: First, a F-106 Delta Dagger in 1/72 scale from Hasegawa straight OOB. I got this kit at last month's meeting. I was surprised to see that the old decals were usable. Next, three tanks in 1/48 scale: a M4 Sherman, a Tiger I, and a Tiger II (early turret) from Tamiya. These were my first attempts at 1/48 scale armor. All were nice kits and were built OOB. Next is a Mark IV Male in 1/72 scale from Emhar. I'm trying a small diorama with some old Airfix figures I had in my spares box. Now two 1/35 scale builds. First, a Tamiya Sd.Kfz 251 halftrack along with four figures from Dragon. I was attempting my first diorama with snow cover and mud. Next, a Marder III. The crew was modified from assorted parts from my spares box. Finally, a 1/48 SPAD XIII from Dragon, in the show birds scheme used by the 94th Aero Squadron after WWI.




























Dick Beemer: This is a 1/35 Russian "flat" car from Miniart. It came with rails and ties, but the base and ballast are my addition. On the rail car is a 1/35 ZIS-5 cargo truck from Hobby Boss. I intended to put something in the truck bed, but I don't know what.





Bill Vinikour: I finally finished this amazingly detailed resin kit of a Knights Templar that required essentially no prep work prior to painting. Most parts could be joined magnetically, which allows to alternate the use of a knight without a helmet, a helmeted knight, or a zombie head (no need to wonder which one I chose). While the Knights' actual outfits were white with red details, I decided to use a red outfit with black details. The outfit was weathered with paints, pigments, and some model mud mixed with some static grass. The kit also came with a detailed stone base which I further detailed with static grass, weeds, vines, some slate, ferns, real dirt and stones, Woodland Scenics' grass and foliage clump pieces, and various plastic and preserved plants. I used various colors of pigments to add lichen to the stones. The metal flagpole that came with the kit was heavily weathered with rust-colored paints and pigments. I used a peanut bowl purchased at a resale shop for the base of the model. The finished model is about 24 inches tall.




Bill Vinikour: I had quite a model haul courtesy of Santa. Many of the kits were Reaper Bones and few other gaming company critter- and monster-type kits for a diorama or two I plan on making for our next Show. Among the kits I got for Christmas is the first "great" kit that Ban Dai has produced: the 1/32 scale *T. rex* skeleton model. I also received (bought myself) two bust models. The first is "Return of the Reich — Panzerkommandant Jürgen" by Quarantine Studio. This ½-scale bust is a German Panzer tank commander who was blown up in his tank, but instead of dying was turned to a zombie! The other is a resin human anatomy medical mini-size model (about ½ scale) from Global-Dental that features the musculature of the human head. I plan on turning it into a zombie bust. Finally, I picked up several Metal Earth kits.


