

June 2022 Meeting Recap and Other News

President John Novak brought the meeting to order, with 24 folks in attendance. John discussed the kits he brought in for giveaway at the meeting, and that additional kits will be brought to future meetings. John mentioned that he now has over 200 items listed on Scalemates. If you have kits you no longer want, you can have them added to Scalemates and then select other kits from the list in exchange. John will email club members a link to the Scalemates site. John wants to keep the Show raffle like it was at our last Show. That raffle was very profitable for our club. In contrast, our club meeting auction does not generate much revenue. John believes that we could still have an in- meeting auction but would need to plan this well in advance.

Treasurer Hector Colón mentioned he received an email from Aeronaut Books (https://aeronautbooks.com), who are going to send us copies of some of their books for our November Show. He will be sending out vendor letters about our November show this weekend. Hector welcomes suggestions for ways to improve our November Show. Show flyers need to be placed at hobby shops and at other shows to help publicize our November Show. We will be hosting the 2024 Regional IPMS Show. It will occur in June and be held in Building 1 at the DuPage County Fairgrounds.

A discussion was given by members who went to Wonderfest. Mike Grajek mentioned that his grandfather, Don, left behind many unbuilt kits. He will bring in a list of the kits to give BOH members an opportunity to buy them. The kits that club members do not buy will be for sale at Mike's dealer table at our November Show.

Show and tell then took place (see these elsewhere in the Newsletter). Following show and tell, there was a discussion of the Midway BOH Club-only build planned for the November Show. John mentioned that he has a source for Midway-related decals for aircraft. Members should let him know if there are any markings they may need. 





