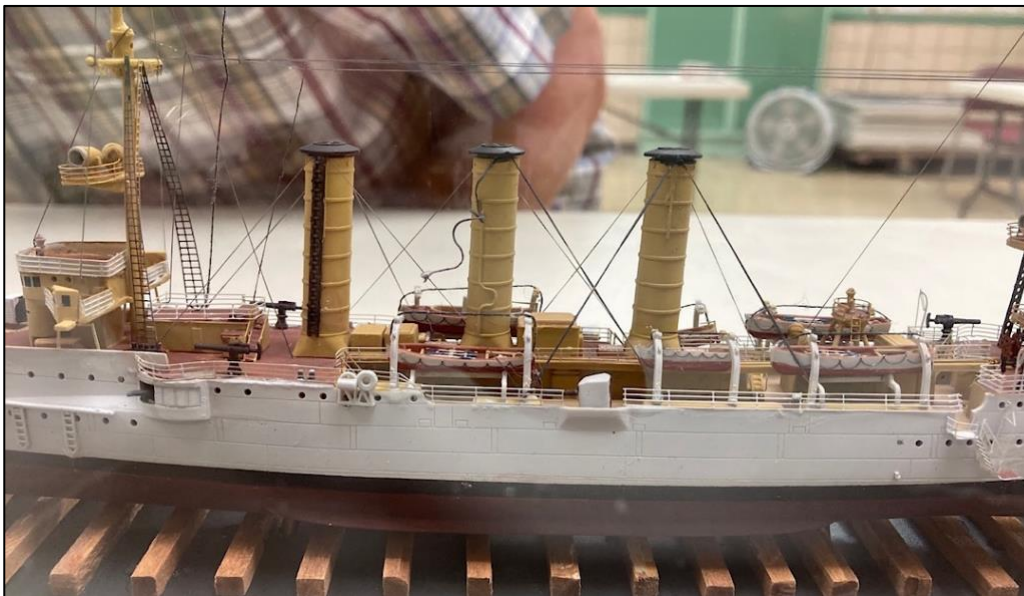

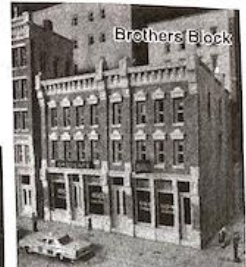

A pleasure to work with, resin sands and cuts easily and neatly, making it excellent for kitbashing. Original and authentic, designs and patterns are created by well-known Bob Lunde.

Each kit features separate doors and windows cast in matte finish, realistic colors. Walls are also cast in matte finish, appropriate colors. Clear window glazing is furnished. Dark gray roofs have cast in details. Parts are machined to provide smooth, flat back surfaces, to remove flash and to create clean-fitting 45° angle corners. Tab and slot locators appear where appropriate at butt joints. Use gap-filling ACC and flexible silicone glues.

You can build an impressive city in a surprisingly small space.
