










Hector Colon: 1/24 3D-printed 2017 Ford Coyote engine (amazing detail) to go into a '69 Mustang, some crates, and other accessories for a planned diorama; Iceman Collections.






Steve Lipke: 1/16 T-34 76C in-progress; Trumpeter. Steve used Aves epoxy putty to simulate the surface texture of the tank.



Bob Frysztak: 1/72 'Steal Beast' tank from 1st Indiana Jones movie, to go on his Indiana Jones pinball machine; resin kit from RetrokiT,Retro SF. A 'difficult' build – horse missing two legs, commandant missing an arm, poor instructions, lots of flash. Bob scratch built much of the details (e.g., ropes, cables, hand rails).









Kevin Shea: 1/24 2021 Charger, 1967 Shelby Mustang, and '69 Pontiac Super Bee. Kevin built the Charger for his step-daughter, her favorite car. On the Super Bee, Kevin used blue painters tape for the vinyl roof, painted satin black!













Johnny Novak: 1/72 de Havilland Vampire FB.52; Special Hobby. Poor fuselage fit required lots of putty and sanding. Even though he added weights to the nose, it is still a 'tail sitter.'





Stan Kurcz: 1/72 Lockheed Electra, Special Hobby, and a 1/72 F-22, Italeri. While the Electra kit looked good, it had virtually no locating features, the engines didn't fit te cowlings (which needed to be ground out) – NOT a beginner's kit. The scheme is based on Amelia Earhart's plane. The F-22 was a painting challenge - first two attempts needed to be stripped, while 3rd time was a charm. The air intakes needed a lot of sanding/grinding to get a good fit.



Mike Knowski: A variety of Eduard WW I aircraft, and a Special Hobby Lloyd C.V, all 1/72, and a '68 and a '69 Road Runner, both 1/25 from AMT.























We could use help at the vendor and contest registration desks, the raffle table, and judging. Think of this as great practice for our 2024 Regional show, where we will really need all hands-on deck!!
