# September 8, 2023 Meeting Recap and Other News

President John Novak brought the meeting to order. There were 25 people in attendance. John opened a discussion on our upcoming November 4 show. He emphasized that we need more volunteers to help out at the show. In particular, more judges are needed for the model contest.

Omer Houston (the head judge for our model contest) then led a discussion on the 'Best in Show' issue from last year and judging in general. One of the major issues from last year's show was that a few individuals believed that the gold medal winner for ship models should have also won best of show. This initiated a lively discussion on how the judges determine best of show, how one can compare a scratch built wooden ship model to a highly detailed plastic model, and so forth. It was even discussed to possibly have a separate "best of" for nautical models.

Regarding the judging process at our show, the general consensus among those that judged was that the app used by the judges worked well. Unless we can get more people involved in judging, judging teams will be comprised of two-man rather than the preferred three-man teams. Where there is a dispute between judging team members, Omer (as head judge) would cast a deciding vote. It was also decided that we would not close the contest room during judging. Thus, judging teams should be aware that the builder of a kit may be within ear shot, so discussions by a judging team should be constructive. Also, judging could be initiated as soon as possible so that there will be adequate time near the end of the show for special awards to be decided upon.

Show-and-Tell was then held, with the theme of "Korean War".

The theme for the October meeting is "USAF".

**Bill Vinikour**: Bill showed an almost completed 1/150 Ma'al Drakar the Dragon Tyrant, Reaper Miniatures. Bill painted the dragon using acrylic inks and Vallejo paints, and detailed the base using pigments and Woodland Scenics products.







**Carl Knable**: A 1/72 A-10 from Hobby Boss, done in a 1991 experimental camo scheme ("Peanut scheme") that was not adopted; an 1/72 F-105D from Revell done in a pre-1965 bare metal finish; and a 1/72 Westland Sea King also from Revell.










**Dick Beemer:** More progress on his 1/25 scratch build of a depot 'mule' truck as seen at a Villa Park truck company. Only the tires are not scratch built.







**Nick D.: A** 1/20 Porsche 928 from Tamiya. Nick built this for a friend. An old kit from a friend getting rid of his stash. Some pieces were missing, including the diver door, so he had to learn numerous new techniques, including making molds/casting resin pieces and making decals. *Well done!!!* 





**Mike Knowski:**. For the Sept theme (Korean War), Mike brought in two 1/72 F-84s from Minicraft and Tamiya, and a 1/72 F-86 from Minicraft. He also brought in a WW II a B-17G in 1/72 from Revell. The metal finishes were done using Alclad lacquers.
















**Ihor Hlohowskyj**: 1/72 KhAl-3 from MikroMir. A very weird mid-30s soviet passenger plane powered by a 125hp tractor engine. What started out to be a quick build of a kit with 28 numbered parts quickly turned into a 'nightmare' build. No locating pins, poor molds, flash, and terrible fit! Made me work on my puttying, sanding, and scribing skills. Only added seat belts made from Tamiya tape and copper wire head rests. Painted using Tamiya and Vallejo Metal Color acrylics.







# Al Race: A 1/48 Cessna O2A from Revell








Jim Pinc: 1/120 B-29 from Atlantis, and a 1/24 Cobra 289 from AMT


