

February 2023 Meeting Recap and Other News

President John Novak brought the meeting to order. There were 25 people in attendance. John led a discussion on new tooling underway for several model kit companies. Treasurer Hector Colón addressed our bank balance. He then discussed the IPMS regional show that our club will host on June 22, 2024 (the third Saturday of the month). The show will be held in Building 1 at the DuPage County Fairgrounds (the large building across from Buildings 2/3 where our last two shows have been held). We will be using IPMS categories and judging rules. There will only be one gold, silver, and bronze award per category. We will need a lot of members to step up and help with the show, particularly for judging. It was also mentioned that the **Armor Modeling and Preservation Society (**AMPS) will be holding its international show on April 11, 2024, at South Bend. That show attracts many international modelers.

Newsletter Editor Ihor Hlohowskyj discussed the list he presented in the February 2023 Newsletter of people that have brought in (or showed on Zoom) their models over the last several years. He suggested that members should bring in completed versions of the "in progress" kits they have previously brought in. He also recommended that members should bring in kits they may have completed years ago but have not brought in; and that those members that have never or seldom brought items to show and tell do so.

Show and tell was then held; tonight's theme was "Anything with Figures."

The decals came from Peddinghaus – very thick and took almost a full bottle of Micro Sol to settle into the corrugated surfaces) Added Eduard seat belts to the cockpit, and Tamiya tape for seat belts in the cabin.











