The theme for the July 12th meeting is "1970s Muscle Cars."



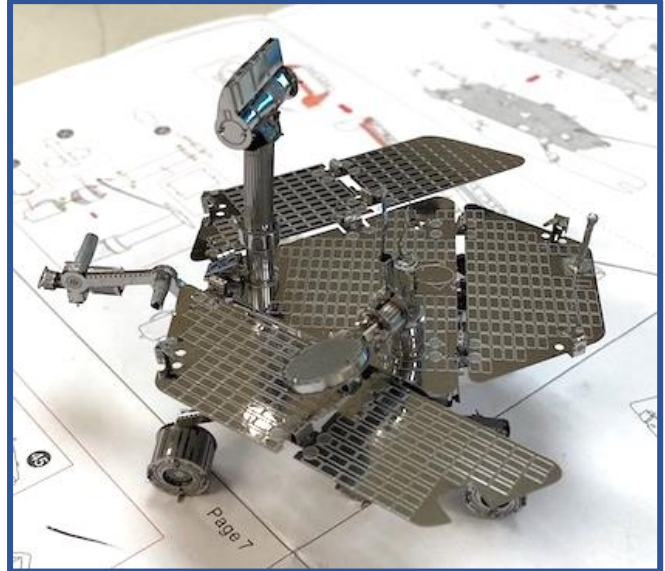
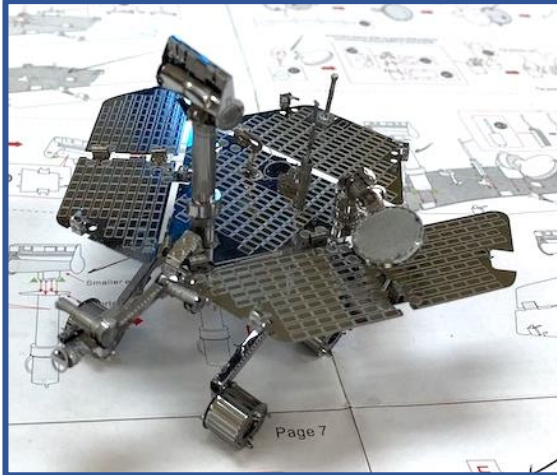

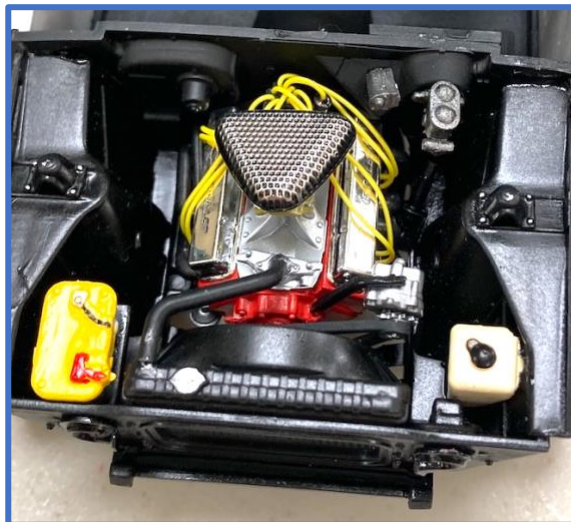

The Sturmtiger has home-made zimmerit and the Panzer 38(t) has paper mache tarps. Oliver accidentally dropped the Star Destroyer which subsequently broke, so he decided to build it as crashed – ‘when life gives you lemons, make lemonade’. The ocean for the CV-8 Hornet was made using crinkled foil!

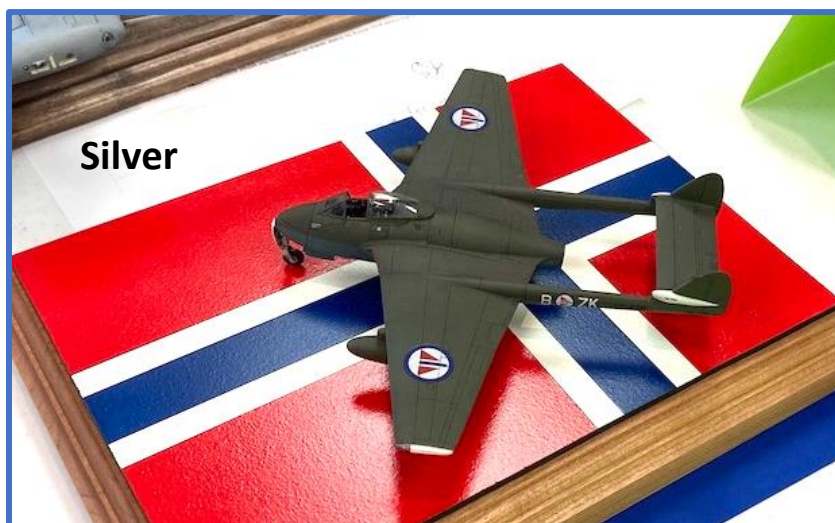
BOH at NIMCON 12
