September 13, 2024 Meeting Recap and Other News

President John Novak brought the meeting to order. There were 21 people in attendance. John discussed our upcoming November 2 IPMS Region V Show that we will be hosting. We are currently in need of selling more vendor tables. There are a few upcoming shows where we can solicit more vendors and leave cards for our Show. These include the Toy Show to be held September 29 at the DuPage County Fairgrounds and the IPMS Duneland Show to be held October 12 at Hobart, IN. Everything is on track for our Show.

Hector Colon again discussed the Bases by Bill "medals" we are going to use for our Regional Show on November 2. They will be square plexiglass awards. The lower half will have the Regional Show information. That portion can be removed; therefore, we will be able to use any leftover awards for future shows. He passed around two versions of the awards for attendees to vote on. It was decided to go with the version with the larger award type lettering and smaller Butch O'Hare logo rather than the one with the larger Butch O'Hare logo and smaller award type lettering. Hector also provided an update on Mike Knowski's condition. He appears to be on the mend.

John then led a discussion on topics such as gloss finishing, kits he recently picked up in California, chrome finishing, and using Mr. Surfacer pink to aid in painting yellow and red.
