An example was given of a model builder on YouTube that shared his collection of sanding tools. Nick said that the collection exceeded 30 sanding tools and included ones he had never seen. Jon went on to share the example of single bladed nippers that modelers use on Gundams and how they preserve the quality of the cuts of the sprues. He also described how the panel lining process that the Gundam builders use are levels above the way we have been doing them on our car and aircraft models.
